

Svarāṣṭaka Śikṣā with Commentary

Introduction

Svarāṣṭaka Śikṣā belongs to the Mādhyandina branch of Śukla Yajurveda. Its main sections are Acsandhi (vowel sandhi), Svaraprakaraṇa (section on accents), Hastaprakṣepalakṣaṇa (knowledge of moving the hand to indicate the accents), Halsandhi (consonant sandhi) and Visargasandhi. At the end the Pratyahāra Sūtras of Pāṇini are shown.

(3) Svaraprakaraṇam (Section on accents)

Now (begins) the chapter of accents (svara). Udātta, anudātta, svarita and pracaya are the accents.

The udātta is not marked with red color.

Note: In the manuscripts the accents are shown in red color.

Example for the fourth accent (pracaya) which is not marked with red color and follows a svarita: tryambakam̄ yajāmahe (MS 3.60)

Svarita is fivefold. According to the division into jātya, abhinihita, kṣaipra and praśliṣṭa svaritas:

In a single word jātya svarita is connected with y or v which is preceded by anudātta or not preceded by anything.

Examples for the jātya svarita:

dhānyām (धान्यम्) (MVP 1.20); *svāḥ* (स्वः) (MVP 18.50)

Note: ekapade nīcapūrvah sayavo jātyah (VP 1.111)

udāttādeśeraco'bhinihitasvarito bhavatyakāralope sati | te'avantu | tevantu | vedah
asi | vedo'si 8

If after udātta “e” or “o” the anudātta “a” is dropped the accent of “e” or “o” becomes the abhinihita svarita.

Examples for the abhinihita svarita:

te | *gvāntu* => *tēvantu* (MVK 19.57); *vedah* | *gsi* => *vēdōsi* (वेदोसि) (MS 2.21)

Note: edodbhyāmakāro lugabhinihitah (VP 1.114)

udātta'i'usthāne yavayoh paro'nudāttah kṣaiprah | yuyoddhyasmat | nu'indra |
nvindra 9

If udātta “i” or udātta “u” which is followed by an anudātta is replaced by “y” or “v” the anudātta becomes the kṣaipra svarita.

Examples for the kṣaipra svarita:

yuyodhi | *gsmat* => *yuyodhyāsmat* (MS 5.36)

nu | *indra* => *nviṇdra* (MS 3.51)

Note: yuvarnau yavau kṣaiprah (VP 1.115)

udāttānudāttayorhrasvayoh sthāne'ikārah praśliṣṭah ||
vi'ita | vvīta 10

In the combination of a short udātta “i” and a short anudātta “i” the praśliṣṭa svarita is created.

Example for the praśliṣṭa svarita:

vi | *itg* => *vitā* (MS 12.45)

Note: ivarṇa ubhayatohrasvah praśliṣṭah (VP 1.116)

anudāttapūrvajātyādayaścatvārah pitṛdānavaddhastam || vāyavyaih' || bhuvaḥ svah

When the four independent svaritas jātya etc.(abhinihitā, kṣaipra and praśliṣṭā) are preceded by anudāttā the hand has the same position as in the case of offering oblation to the ancestors.

Note: (*a - s*) with the exception of (*a - s - u*) (svarita is marked with the konna symbol _)

Examples:

vāyavāyaiḥ (MS 19.27)

bhuvaḥ svāḥ (स्वः (MS 3.37)

When the four independent svaritas jātya etc.(abhinihitā, kṣaipra and praśliṣṭā) are preceded by anudāttā and followed by udāttā the hand should be in the same position as in the case of making an offering to human beings.

Note: (*a - s - u*) (svarita is marked with the nyubja symbol _)

Examples:

bhūrbhuvaḥ svārdyaauriva (भूर्भुवः स्वर्द्यौरिव) (MS 3.5)

sadānyāmiti (सदान्यमिति) (MVP 34.21)

Independent svarita [not preceded by anudātta] becomes anudātta before udātta or svarita.

The four independent svaritas jātya etc. (abhinihita, kṣaipra and praśliṣṭa) not preceded by anudātta and not followed by udātta or svarita (should be indicated) at the root of the ear.

Examples:

nyāñ (न्यङ्)

** nyāñkūn (न्यङ्कून्) (MVP 24.27)*

svāḥ (स्वं) (MVP 18.50)

te'vantu (तेवन्तु) (MVK 19.57)

sōsmi (सोस्मि) (MVK 2.28)

tryāmbakam (त्र्यम्बकम्) (MS 3.60)

vīta (वीत) (MVK 12.45)

udāttātparānudāttam svaritam | işe ttvā 15

After udātta an anudātta becomes svarita.

Example:

isē tvā (इषे त्वा) (MVK 1.1)

nodāttasvaritaparattve | işe tvorjje | īśā vāsyam |

Not before udātta or svarita.

Examples:

iṣe tvorje (इषे त्वोर्जे) (MS 1.1)

īśā vāsyám (ईशा वास्यम्) (MS 40.1)

svaritādanudāttānāṁ pracayaḥ | vvāyavastha 16

After svarita anudāttas become pracaya.

Example:

vāyavā stha (वायवं स्थ) (MS 1.1)

nodāttasvaritaparattve | vvāyavastha devaḥ | vvāsyamidam 17

Not before udātta or svarita.

Examples:

vāyavā stha devaḥ (वायवं स्थ देवः) (MS 1.1)

vāsyamidam (वास्यमिदम्) (MS 40.1)

Example:

pra / arpayatu => prārpayatu (MVK 1.1)

After an udātta an anudātta becomes svarita; after svarita an anudātta becomes pracaya; the anudātta remains unchanged before udātta or svarita. (Svarāṅkuśa Śikṣā 2)

Anudātta is known to be in the heart. The udātta is mentioned as in the head. The svarita should be in the root of the ear. The pracaya is proclaimed to be at the tip of the nose.

Examples:

iṣe tvā (इषे त्वा) (MK 1.1)

vāyavā stha (वायवं स्थ) (MS 1.1)

udāttādanudātta tu vāmāyā bhruva'ārabhet | iṣe ttvorje |

In the sequence udātta-anudātta one should begin at the left eye-brow.

Example:

iṣe tvɔrje (इषे त्वोर्जे) (MS 1.1)

Note: For the accents anudātta + udātta + anudātta the positions of the hand are heart + left eye-brow + root of the ear.

In the sequence udātta + svarita one should indicate the udātta at the right eye-brow.

Example:

iṣe tvā (इषे त्वा) (MK 1.1)

Note: For the accents anudātta + udātta + svarita the positions of the hand are: heart + right eye-brow + root of the ear.
